Ukulele Days hit #13 on the World Billboard Charts and #15 on the Jazz Billboard Charts (alongside Diana Krall and Norah Jones) in its first week of sales.

"Like many creative projects, I didn't know where the 100 Days of Ukulele Songs project would lead. I loved hearing from my fans how surprised they were by the ukulele's versatility across musical genres, and how the project changed their perceptions of ukulele and even inspired them to pick it up as their first instrument."

Ukulele Days costs \$25 on limited edition vinyl, \$15 on CD and .99 per track on digital download.
